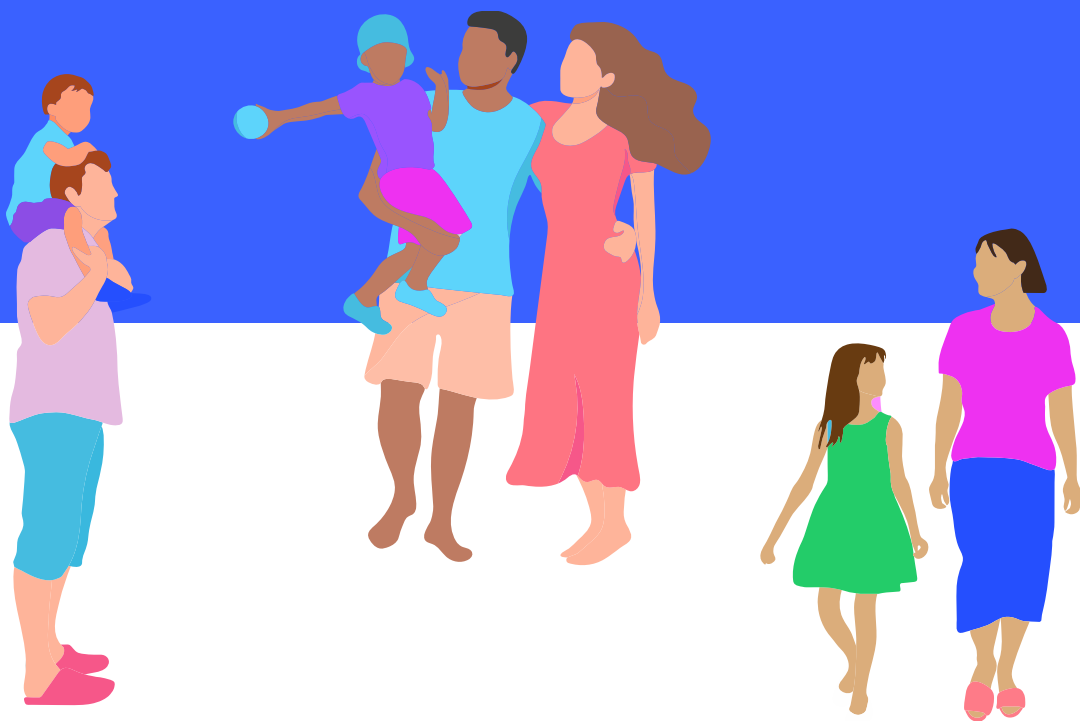

WHERE TO MEET OTHER PARENTS ?

The LAEP (Lieu d'Accueil Enfants-Parents – Centre for children and parents)

The **LAEP** is a social space where children from 0 to 6 years old are welcome with their parents or the adults in charge of them, free of charge.

The adults are responsible for the children in their care and stay at the LAEP with them.

All staff members at the LAEP are **trained in infant care**, whether they be volunteers or professionals.

The LAEP allows the child **to meet other children and adults**.

Children can increase their creativity and learn to go towards new people. It is a **friendly space** that prepares little by little the child to be separated from his/her parents, to go to school for instance.



It is also an important place for adults : it is an opportunity to **meet other parents** with young children and to talk with the staff.

WHERE TO MEET OTHER PARENTS ?

La Maison des Parents (The Parent House)

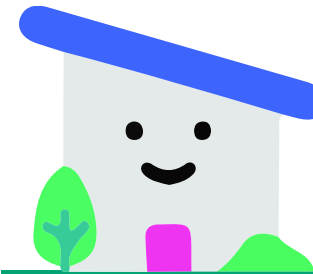
- The Parent House** offers free activities for the whole family. Trained staff members are here to listen to parents, give them advice and assistance.

La Cabane des Mille Premiers Jours (The Hut of the first Thousand Days)

- The Hut of the first Thousand Days** offers free services around care and prevention. It also organises workshops for children from birth to 6 years old.

Les Centres Sociaux ou Maisons pour Tous (Social Centres and Community Centres)

- The Social Centres or Community Centres** offer many free services :
 - support in administrative procedures,
 - advice for parents on education,
 - parent/children activities...

HOW TO FIND CHILDCARE FOR MY CHILD ?

Some useful information

- The RPE (Relais Petite Enfance – information centres on childcare)**
are places where parents may get information on daycare options for their children (collective or individual daycare, on-going or occasional, at home or in a crèche...) and on access to rights.

Prestation de service unique (one-time service benefit)

With the **PSU (Prestation de Service Unique)** system, costs are calculated on an hourly basis and parents **do not need to pay in advance.**

No advance payment

Prestation d'Accueil du jeune enfant (early childhood benefit)

Parents benefiting from the **PAJE (Prestation d'Accueil du Jeune Enfant)** have to **pay the whole bills** and are reimbursed by the CAF afterwards.

Payment in full before reimbursement



WHAT ARE THE CHILDCARE OPTIONS ?

There are various options of childcare which **adapt to the families' needs** : working or training schedules, place of living, number of children...



COLLECTIVE CHILDCARE

(children are looked after in groups)

From birth to 3 years old

- **Collective crèche (daycare nursery)**
(run by the town council, the department, an association or company)
- **AVIP crèche**
(with occupational integration purposes)
- **Multi-accueils (combining different options or childcare), halte-garderie (part-time drop-in centre)**

From 2 to 3 years old

- **Toute Petite Section (very small section) of preschool**



INDIVIDUAL CHILDCARE

(children are looked after alone or in very small groups)

From birth to 6 years old

- **Assistant ou assistante maternelle** (professional childminder taking care of children in his/her home)
- **Crèche familiale** (mini-nursery in the childminder's home)
- **MAM** (Maison d'Assistantes Maternelles – Childminders House)
- **Auxiliaire parentale (nanny)**
Childcare at the parents's home

In France, school is free and compulsory from the age of 3.

*For parents whose work schedules are incompatible with school schedules, options of individual childcare are available

COLLECTIVE CHILDCARE



EAJE (Établissements d'Accueil de Jeunes Enfants – Centres for young children)

- EAJE include collective crèches, multi-accueils, micro-crèches, haltes-garderies, crèches éphémères (short-lived crèches), employer childcare... They offer options of collective childcare for working parents first and foremost.

Collective crèches

- Collectives crèches provide day care to children from birth to 3 years old, often full-time.

Micro-crèches

- Micro-crèches can host a maximum of 12 children, from birth to 3 years old, often full-time.

Haltes-garderies

- Haltes-garderies are like part-time drop-in centres for children from birth to 6 years old, a few hours or some half-days per week.

Multi-accueils

- Multi-accueils combine different options : on-going, occasional or urgent daycare.

Parentales crèches

- Parental crèches are nurseries providing care to children from 0 to 3 years, often full-time. They are run by parents : parents and professional staff take part in the activities and in administrating the crèche.

AVIP crèches (with occupational integration purposes)

- AVIP crèches provide care to children whose parents are looking for work. Children are looked after a minimum of 3 days per week. Parents can be supported by Pôle Emploi-France Travail (job centres) or Mission Locale (community aid projects for young people) to help them find a job.

Ecoles maternelles (pre-schools)

- Children can attend Ecoles maternelles from the age of 2 in Toute Petite Section (very small section) level (children should be potty-trained).

INDIVIDUAL CHILD CARE

Assistante maternelle (professional childminder)

- The assistante maternelle** is a professional childminder who looks after up to 4 children in his/her own home.

The department authorities and the Protection Maternelle et Infantile (PMI) (maternal and child protection) verify his/her ability to look after young children and check that the home is suitable and safe for children.

The family employs the childminder directly : a work contract is signed at the beginning, payslips are issued each month.

The CAF, Pôle Emploi-France Travail or the Department may grant financial assistance.

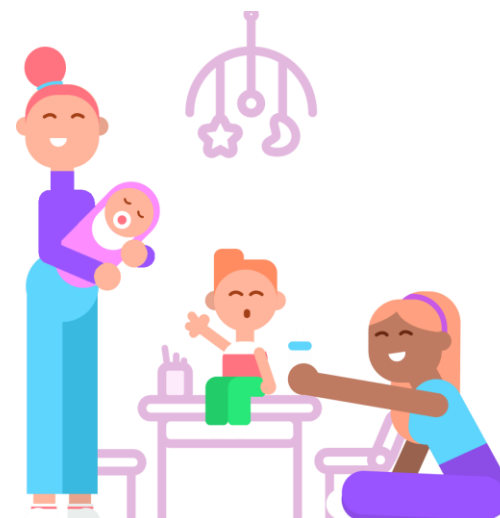
Familial crèches

- Familial crèches** provide care to children sometimes in the childminder's home, sometimes in a crèche.

In-home child care (nanny)

- A nanny** looks after children in the parents' home.

Two families may employ the same nanny to share costs.



WHO CAN HELP ME KNOW MY RIGHTS ?

The Centre Communal d'Action Sociale (CCAS) (community social action association)

Provides guidance with administrative formalities and application for social benefits : RSA (social benefit for the poorest), Allocations Solidarité Personnes Âgées (solidarity allowance for the elderly), Aide Sociale à l'Hébergement (social assistance for the accommodation of an elderly person), MDPH (disability benefits)...

Provides support for problems of housing, over-indebtedness...

Provides an address for families without a fixed address.

Offers financial assistance to buy food, pay bills...

Offers support to women who have experienced domestic violence.



Caisse d'Allocations Familiales (CAF) (family branch of the French social security system)

The CAF supports parents from the beginning of pregnancy, until the child's third birthday. The CAF informs parents about family benefits, social support, childcare...

Centre d'Information sur les Droits des Femmes et des Familles (CIDFF) (Information centre on women's and families' rights)

The CIDFF provides information and support to women (mostly) in matters of family, health, parenthood, family and domestic violence...

The services promoting access to rights **provide information to anyone.**

WHO CAN HELP ME KNOW MY RIGHTS ?

Financial problems

- **The Union Départementale des Associations Familiales (UDAF)** : Local Union of Family Organisations. It offers advice on creating and managing a budget.

Family conflicts

- **Family mediation** helps to solve family conflicts, for instance, when parents separate.

Social mediation may provide help to a family on two conditions :

- both parties are willing to participate.
- there is no violence within the family.

Domestic violence

- **SOS Femmes (SOS Women)** provides support to mothers suffering from domestic violence.

Child protection

- **The Aide Sociale à l'Enfance (ASE) (child protection)** provides assistance to families needing support in the education and care of the child. The ASE may grant financial support, send an educator...

The ASE may also suggest removing the child from the parents' care.

If the child's situation is urgent, the ASE can quickly provide shelter.



HOW TO FIND MEDICAL CARE FOR MY CHILD ?

The Protection Maternelle et Infantile (PMI) (mother and child protection)

- The **PMI** provides assistance to pregnant women, parents and children under 6 years old.

The PMI offers **medical consultations** and advice on nutrition, education, sexuality, contraception...



The PMI also provides **information and support** regarding child protection.

The Maison Départementale des Personnes Handicapées (MDPH – House of Disabled People) of Seine-Saint-Denis

- The **MDPH** provides information to people with disabilities and their families to facilitate administrative procedures and daily life with a disability.

The Centres Médico-Psycho-Pédagogiques (CMPP – Medical and Psychopedagogical Centres)

- CMPPs** provide support to children and teenagers with social, mental or family problems. For instance, sleep or eating disorders, difficulties to adapt at school or to talk with other people, depression...

Children and their families get support and follow-up care from the medical staff : psychiatrists, speech therapists, psychologists, nurses...

WHERE CAN I GO OUT AND HAVE FUN WITH MY CHILDREN ?

Playgrounds, squares, parks

- There are a lot of **playgrounds, squares and parks** in Seine-Saint-Denis. There are play areas for children, sports facilities and places to rest.

Games libraries

- Games libraries** offer games for children until 6 years old. Adults are responsible for the children in their charge. The team of the games library is available to introduce the games and the spaces designed to entertain the children.

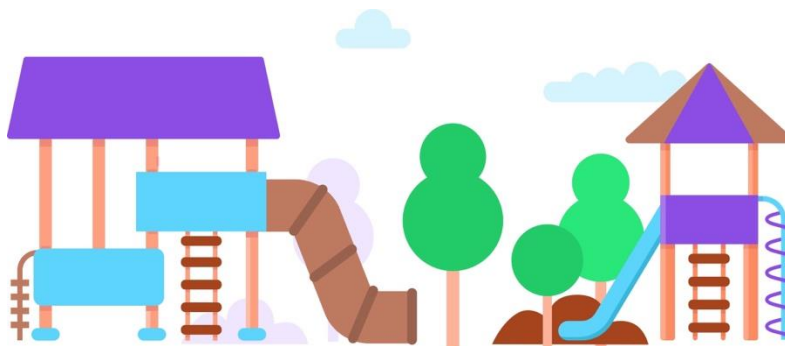
Libraries and multimedia libraries



- Libraries and multimedia libraries** often include spaces for young children, with cushions and child-sized chairs and tables. Adults and children may choose and look at books or listen to music, attend activities, listen to readings...

Parent/children workshops

- Parent/children workshops** are activities offered by many associations and by social centres. Children and their parents may attend together an activity of art (music, painting, dance) or manual work (cooking, handicrafts).

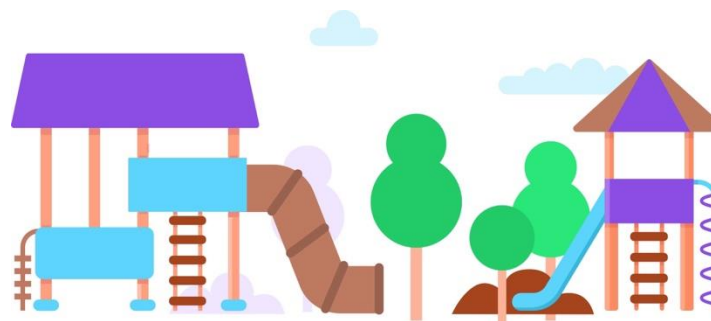
